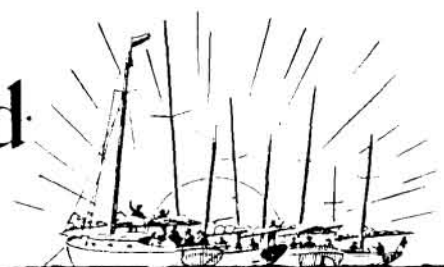

PLAN NOW TO ATTEND THAYER'S CRUISING WEEKEND

September 29 and 30

Boats in the Amityville area: Saturday's "race" starts between the green flasher off Amityville and Big Dipper, all boats starting together at 10:30 am. (Warning @ 10:20, Preparatory @ 10:25)

Boats in the Babylon area: Saturday's "race" starts between the white flasher off Babylon and Big Dipper, all boats starting together at 11:40 am. (Warning @ 11:30, Preparatory @ 11:35)

Course: Cross starting line in an easterly direction. Pass south of either the Fire Islands or Sand Island (or both), and finish in Great River between the south post of the two marking the mouth and Big Dipper. There are no other course marks.

Sunday's "race" starts in Great River between the south entrance post and Big Dipper at 10:10 am. (Warning 10:00, Preparatory 10:05)

Course: Start in an easterly direction, pass south of Sand Island or the Fire Islands, and proceed to finish between Big Dipper and the green flasher at the Lindenhurst channel. There are no other course marks.

Handicaps: South Bay Cruising Club handicaps will be used. Engines may be used in the "Race", all skippers to report their time under power to the Race Committee. Twice the time under power will be added to the elapsed time before figuring the corrected time. Dinks may be towed, the length of dink to be reported to the Committee. The published sec/mi figures will be adjusted by adding a percentage of that figure equal to the length of dink in feet. Example: Time allowance 120 sec/mi, dink 8' long. Add 8% of 120 or 10; new time allowance 130 sec/mi. These handicaps are for these two days only and have no official status. The results will not change your performance factor.

Saturday evening: Beach party and song fest at the small island on the south side of the cut into Great River. Soundings over Labor Day showed 4' on the north side of the island and 7' on the south side. See Big Dipper for Pilotage. Most boats should be able to put their bows on the bank. Bring your own charcoal, food, song books, musical instruments, vocal cord lubricant, etc. If each boat will bring a couple of small logs there should be enough for a good fire lasting into the evening. If Saturday's race is over early enough perhaps some dink races can be arranged. How about a dink race under oars?
