Medicine for Mariners

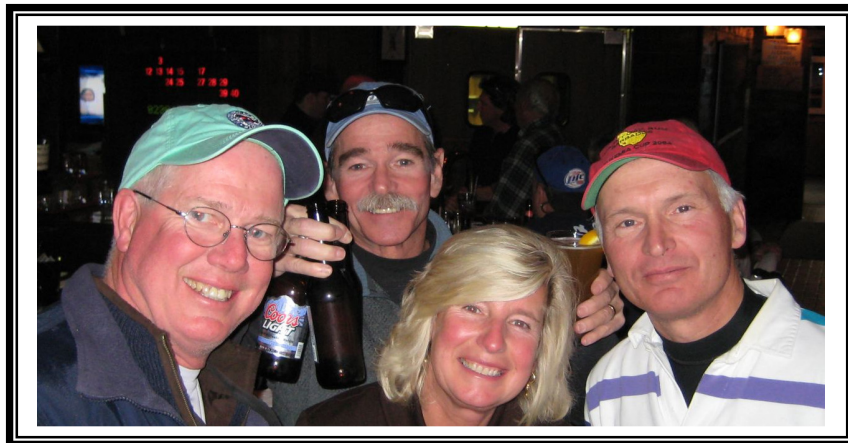
While cruising has anyone aboard experienced an injury? Did you know what action to take?

| 1- 29 oz can crushed tomatoes | 1/8 th teaspoon cayenne or more |

Add oil to kettle with onions and green peppers, sauté for 5 minutes

Blend in cornstarch

Add tomatoes, thyme, salt, bay leaf, corn and cayenne.

Cook over low heat for 20 minutes

Add sausages continue cooking for 15 minutes

Serve with rice
