In addition to adding five tank level monitors, replacing almost the entire exhaust system, all motor mounts, the water heater, and refinishing all external teak (in all fairness, it was just the companionway slats), I also rewired the anchor wash down to something that will no longer be able to burn down the boat and performed an additional dozen or so "minor repairs". Now, we are finalizing a lithium house bank and alternator upgrade before moving on to a solar upgrade. *Haven's* house batteries are a pair group 4D and, while accessible, are in an awkward location. I really have to give Wendy credit. She didn't hesitate to climb onboard and help get those monsters up on deck so the new "light weight" eighty pound lithium batteries could be installed.

That's it for now; I'm looking forward to seeing you at our upcoming events and back out on the water!

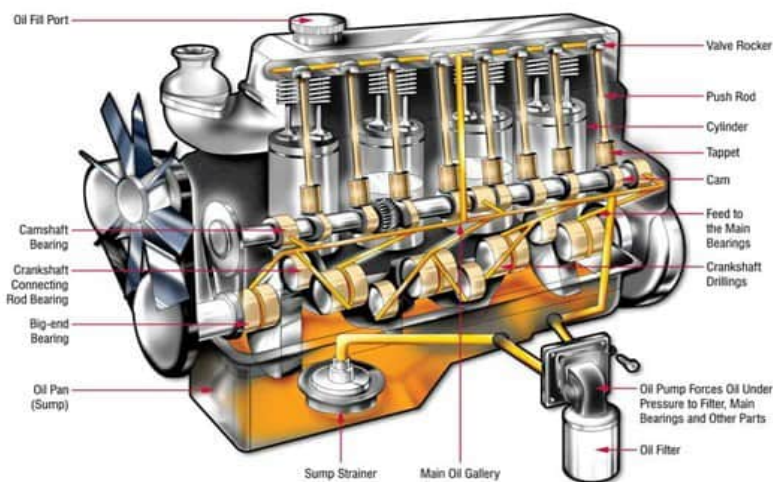
FROM THE PROGRAM COMMITTEE**Todd McCarthy**

There were two seminars hosted by the Program Committee in March. Safety At Sea and Vessel Incident Survival was held on March 9th, hosted by speakers Deke Jamison and Barry Lipsky.

Deke discussed general safety when boating, the importance of filing a float plan, showing your crew where safety equipment is stored, and detailed the critical spare parts to carry aboard. Barry spoke about what can happen aboard a boat and how to survive an emergency aboard.



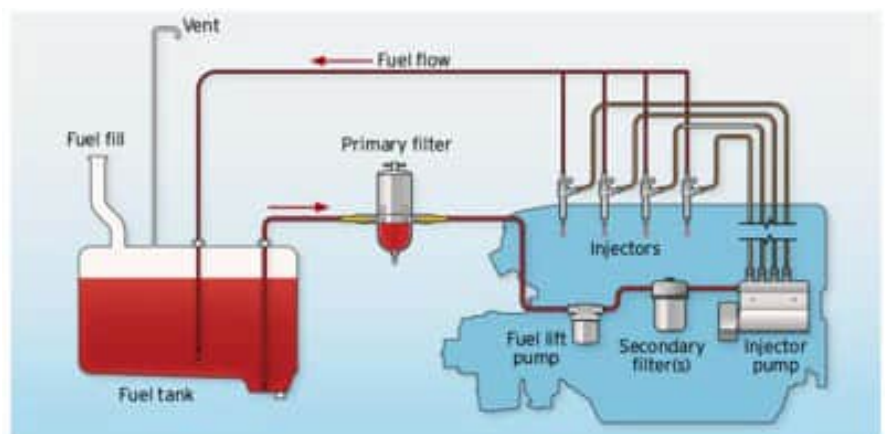
The Marine Diesel Engine Seminar was hosted by Todd McCarthy. An informative video was shown depicting how a diesel engine operates as well as ancillary equipment needed for a marine diesel, such as cooling systems, turbo chargers, and after coolers.



There was a question and answer and discussion session after the video. I brought in some tools to use maintaining a diesel engine, focusing on fuel supply, checking for water in your fuel tank, checking your water pump and replacing impellers, hose removal, and checking your engine RPM

with a laser tachometer.

Coffee and refreshments were served and everyone had a good time catching up with each other. Hope to see you at next season's seminars.

Potatoes Au Gratin

Flori Grottoli

With a bag full of potatoes just sitting there doing nothing, I decided I'd make a dish that would satisfy the potato lover in Claudio. It would have to be hot and cheesy, and easy to make. Even though I had always heard of potatoes au gratin, I had never made the dish. I found a recipe that sounded like something I would enjoy making...and of course, I made it my own. LOL

It is very satisfying on a cold, winter night, both as a main dish or as a side dish for a dinner party. It can also be put together ahead of time and baked right before serving.

Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 cups light cream, room temperature
- 2 tbsp unsalted butter , *melted*
- 2.5 lb starchy potatoes , I used regular Idaho potatoes, sliced to 1/8" thick
- salt and pepper to taste
- 2 1/2 cups gruyere cheese, *grated*
- 2 tsp freshly grated nutmeg, (*original recipe calls for thyme*)

Optional: 1 tbsp cooking sherry (this is not part of the original recipe but it added another layer of flavor to the dish and, along with the nutmeg, made the dish taste lighter)



Instructions:

- Preheat oven to 350°F (both fan and standard ovens).
- Place butter, cream, cooking sherry and nutmeg in a container, mix well and let it stand.
- Peel the potatoes and, using a slicer/mandolin, slice them 1/8" thick.
- Butter the bottom and sides of a Pyrex baking dish, 7" x 11" x 2"
- Start layering like you would with a lasagna; Spread 1/3 of the potatoes at the bottom of the buttered baking dish, salt and pepper the potatoes to taste, then pour 1/3 of the cream mixture over the layer of potatoes.
- Top with 1/3 the shredded cheese
- Repeat for the 2nd and third layer, but **do not finish with cheese** on the top layer.

Potatoes Au Gratin**Flori Grottoli**

- Cover with foil, and bake for anywhere between 1 hour 15 minutes and 1 hour 30 minutes, or until the potatoes in the middle are soft (use knife to test).
- Remove the foil, top with the remaining cheese. Bake for another 10 to 15 minutes and give it a quick minute or two of broiler to get the color just right.

Let the potatoes stand for 5 minutes before serving. REMEMBER THE DISH IS VERY HOT...be careful when serving!
