FROM THE HELM

A few weeks ago I was down at Cook's yard. There was little activity and almost all boats were still on the hard. Fast forward to the end of April: *Haven* has been in the water for a few weeks, and what was once a sea of boats floating on stands is being transformed back into a parking lot where you can actually park a car. What a difference a month makes!

Now that the calendar has flipped to May, we've arrived at the time we've anticipated during the long, cold winter. This article is being written on the hook at Coast Guard Cove; Joe Werkmeister and Christina Pietras just finished hosting the season's first on-water activity, the Hot Chocolate/Hot Toddlers rendezvous. Three boats spent Friday night and weathered the windy Saturday afternoon. Past Commodore Charlie Margeson motored by and joined us for a few hours. It was windy and cool, but also felt great to be back on the water!

With the 2025 rendezvous season in full force, we have an exciting weekend coming up May 17 with the Spring Family Weekend at Atlantique. This corresponds with our first race of the year, the Spring Race to Atlantique. It's always a great time having cruisers and racers get together for an afternoon. For those unable to attend by boat, consider taking the ferry and joining the rest of us for a day at the beach.

This month will continue to be an active one for SBCC. The Tuesday BSIR race series starts on May 27 and we close out May with Commissioning Day at the Bay Shore Yacht Club on May 31. Please RSVP early to assist our hospitality team in their preparations.

PLEASE READ: There are currently two open comment periods from the USCG in which they are requesting comments from the public.

Smith Point Bridge replacement: *public comments close on May 23.*

The existing bascule bridge is proposed to be replaced with a fixed 55' bridge. Vessels with an air draft greater than 55' will only have the unreliable Moriches Inlet to transit outside of Moriches Bay. If you wish to comment on this proposal, the USCG is accepting comments sent to [Don-](#)

na.D.Leoce@uscg.mil. They specifically asked for feedback from sailors.

AIS generated electronic "buoys" to replace select physical buoys: *public comments close on June 13.*

The electronic buoys will only be displayed on chart plotters that receive AIS data. The details of this proposal can be seen at: <https://uscg-marker-removals.webflow.io/>

One buoy proposed for removal is the entrance buoy to the Fire Island Inlet, so this affects all of us that sail off the bay. Comments are to be sent to D01-SMB-DPWPublicComments@uscg.mil with reference to project No. 01-25-015.

If you have a position on either of these proposals, please consider submitting your comments to the email addresses listed above. This is our only opportunity to go on record and let our voices be heard. Both were discussed during the April Board meeting and no one showed support for either proposal. While I intend to submit comments on behalf of SBCC, there is strength in numbers. If you submit comments, it is best to provide justification for your position. Also, feel free to ask questions in a way they will need to justify their reasons for the change.

Russian Salad

The Russian, or Olivier salad, was created in the 1860s by a French chef named Lucien Olivier while working at the Hermitage Restaurant in Moscow. I find this salad not only to be delicious but to be very versatile and very mobile; it can be taken to a holiday gathering to a picnic or on the boat. The base ingredients are always potatoes, carrots, and peas...but the variations are many. Below is the base recipe I love the best. At the end of the recipe, you will find some variations that make the Russian salad your own.

Note: Since all veggies are cooked by boiling them, I find it faster to work with two pots of salted water at the same time. Once one veggie is cooked, I use a hand strainer to take it out of the pot and I add the next veggie directly into the same pot of boiling water. The last item to cook is the eggs, helping myself by using a timer set at 8 minutes.

Ingredients

- ✿ Four - 8-minute hard-boiled eggs (I had leftover Easter eggs and used those in this recipe)
- ✿ 1.5 cups frozen baby peas
- ✿ 1.5 cups string beans - ends removed and cut into bite-size pieces
- ✿ 1 cup peeled and diced carrots
- ✿ 2 cups potatoes, sliced then cut into cubes
- ✿ 1/2 cup chopped pickles
- ✿ 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- ✿ 1/2 cup plain Greek yogurt
- ✿ 1.5 lemons - freshly squeezed
- ✿ Olive oil, salt, and pepper to taste



Clean and prepare all ingredients while waiting for the water to boil.

Start by cooking the peas in one pot of salted, boiling water and the carrots in the other pot of salted, boiling water. Hand strain, then proceed to cook the next two veggies. Finally, cook the eggs.

Once all veggies and eggs are cooked, allow everything to cool thoroughly. In the meantime, start making the dressing. In a bowl, mix the yogurt, mayonnaise, pickles, and lemon juice until well blended. Set aside. Once the veggies have cooled, taste them to see how salty they are. Adjust salt if necessary and add pepper to taste. Add olive oil and toss to coat well. Once veggies have been coated with olive oil, toss in the dressing. Toss again to coat all veggies evenly. Taste and adjust accordingly. Peel and slice hard-boiled eggs and lay them over the top of the salad. Keep refrigerated.



Variations

- ✿ Add some protein of your choice - a can of tuna fish, some cubed ham, or cubed Swiss cheese.
- ✿ Add pickled veggies - marinated artichokes, giardiniera, or marinated mushrooms.

All these items add an extra level of flavor and interest to the basic recipe.
